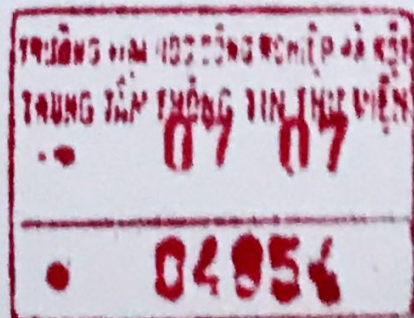

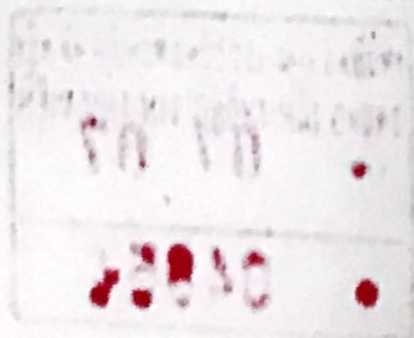

You know how you look out into the class



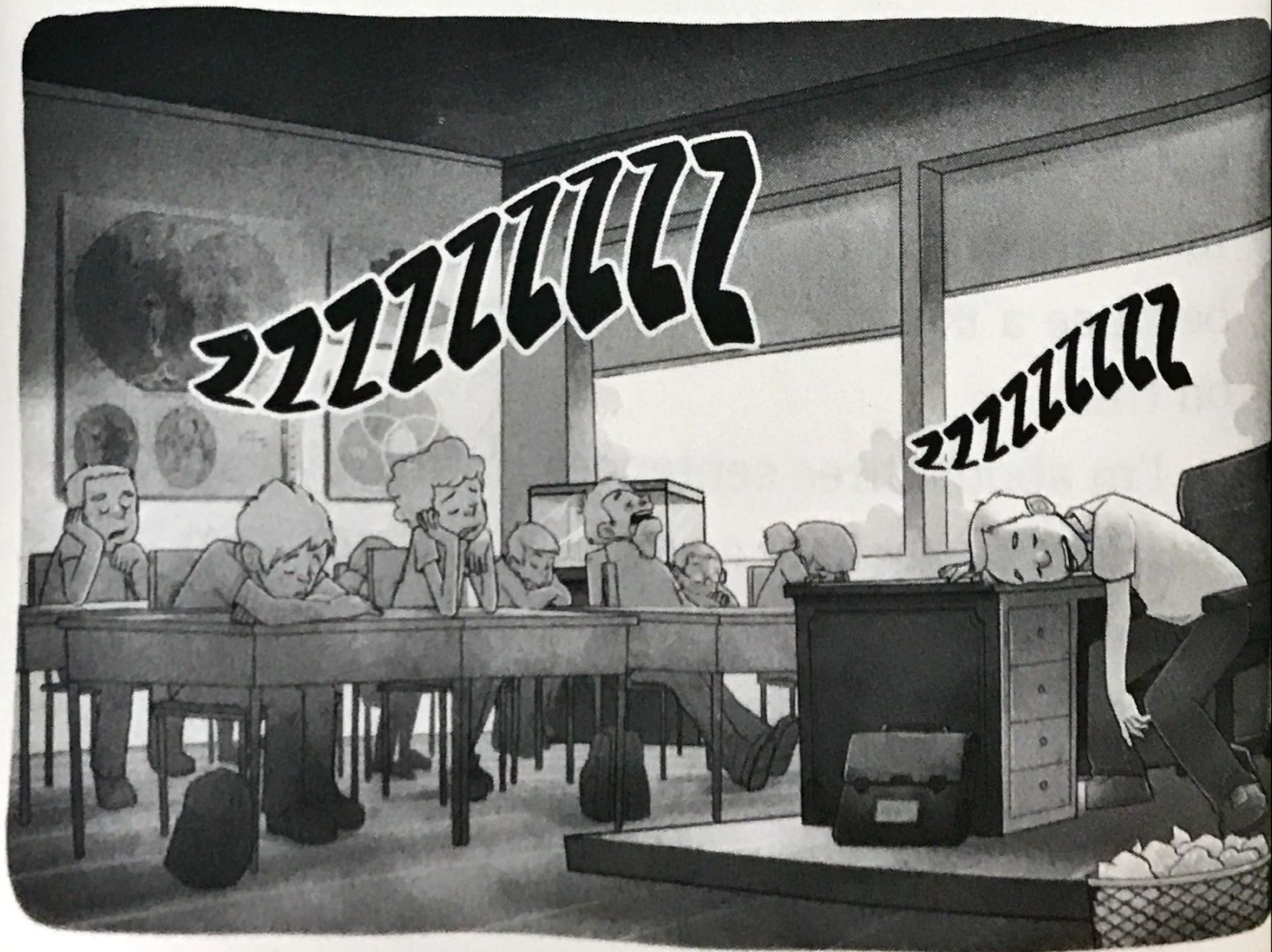
and hope for a bit of encouragement to keep you going? Maybe a smile? Or at the very least, some eye contact?
