Grammar Points


A brief presentation of a particular grammar point which is frequently given in the TOEIC Reading test is shown.


Common Vocabulary in the TOEIC Test





It is a standardized test which provides an accurate measurement of the English capabilities of non-native speakers and allows employers to make hiring decisions, promotions, or transfers depending on job seekers' qualifications and English proficiency. It also enables universities to better prepare their students for the international workplace.
