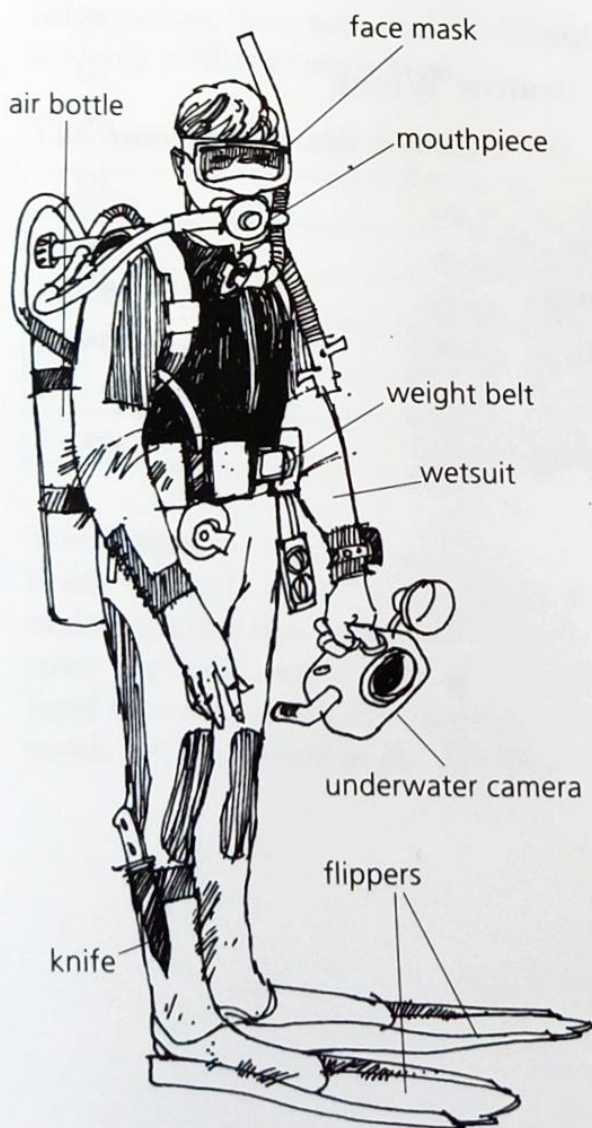

This is an adventure story that takes place in Thailand in South-east Asia. To the south of Thailand is the beautiful blue water of the Gulf of Thailand.

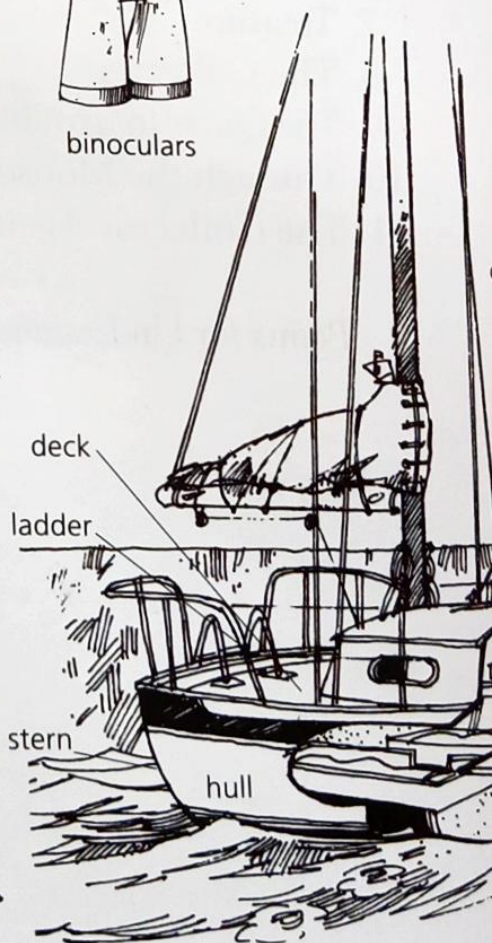

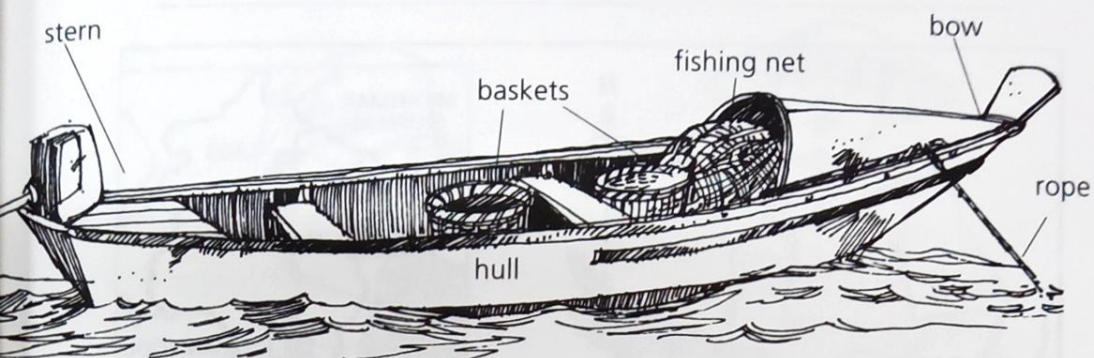

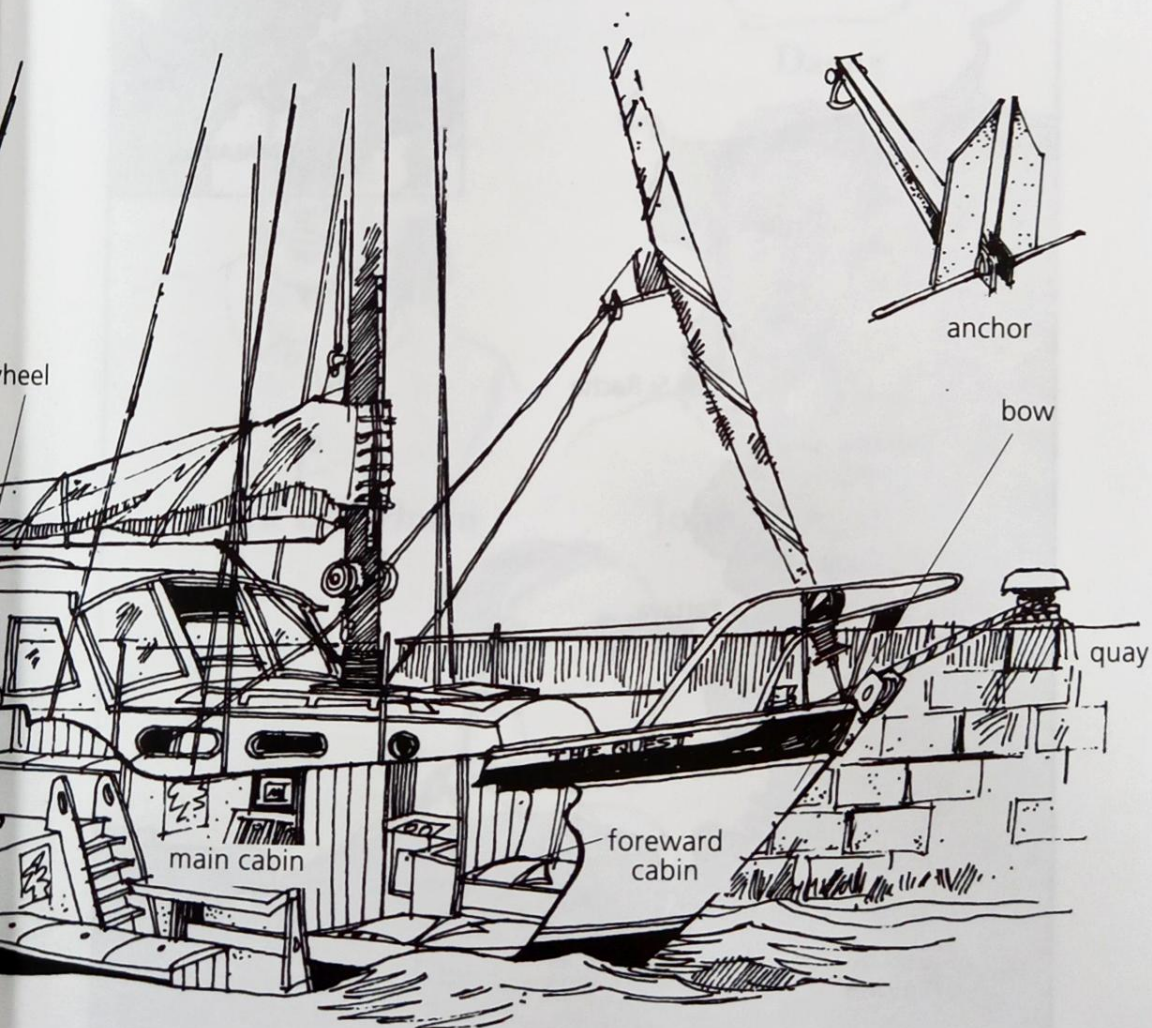
