Introductory Remarks ध्वानग

Overview


Fun! Fun! Korean $2_{\tt J}$ is a text that was developed for beginner learners of the Korean language so that the learners can have fun while studying Korean with ease. The text is composed of materials that focus on approaches to daily activities. This was made in order for the learners to familiarize themselves with the necessary themes and functions useful in the daily lives, especially to communicate one's thoughts effectively in real life situations. Additionally, the text does not teach by the structure or the concept of grammar and mere explanation of vocabulary but through various speaking activities and by having fun. Through these types of activities, the learners of Korean will be able to communicate their thoughts in real life naturally without even recognizing it themselves.

Goals

- · Achieve everyday basic communication ability such as introducing oneself, shopping, etc..
- Understand and express content based on one's daily and personal life such as introduction of oneself, family, daily activities, etc..
- Ask and answer simple questions in one's everyday life by familiarizing oneself with basic vocabulary and expressions, pronunciation, etc..
- · Understand Korean conversation on personal and familiar topics.
- Get familiarized with the Korean language and the basic Korean language structure so as to read and understand simple written Korean text, and express oneself in written Korean.

Unit Structure

Fun! Fun! Korean 2₁ is made up of 15 units. The 15 units are composed of topics centering on the potential real life situations that students may experience while living in Korea. Each unit is composed as shown below.





Goals

We have thoroughly described the overall lesson goals and contents (Topic, Function, Activity, Vocabulary, Grammar, Pronunciation, Culture) in the unit so that the students can get acquainted with the lesson goals and contents prior to the lesson.



Introduction

We have suggested a picture relating to the unit's topic including a few questions below. Through the picture and the questions, the students are able to think about the unit's topic beforehand and therefore, are able to prepare for their studies.



Dialogue & Story

This section will be used as a speech sample, in which the students will ultimately use after the completion of this unit. We have suggested 2 dialogues and 1 story. The students can confirm the lesson goals of the corresponding unit with further details through the example.

New Vocabulary

By explaining the new words or the meaning of the expressions that appear next to the example, we have made it easier for the students to understand the content of the dialogue and story.



Speaking Practice

In this section, the students practice and review vocabulary, grammar, etc. in order to perform and achieve the skills laid out in the topic of the corresponding unit. The practice questions are not in the form of ordinary drills but are in the form of speaking chances so that the students can familiarize the vocabulary and grammar orally.

Language Tip

In this section, we have included in depth of the usage of particular expression and its meaning in case further explanation is needed.


Vocabulary

When a new word appears, we explain the meaning of the new words immediately at the time in order to make it easier for the students to study. In addition, next to the vocabulary practice, we suggest that the vocabulary to study be categorized according to the meanings of the word (e.g., vocabulary for food/occupation).



Pronunciation

The following unit presents pronunciations that must be familiarized with. In order for the students to acquire accurate pronunciation, the unit presents simple explanation of pronunciation methods and provides words and sentences that the students could practice with.



Activity

In this section, a real-life, communicative situation is re-enacted so the students can perform practical tasks such as (Listening), (Speaking), (Reading), and (Writing) by using grammar and expressions learned in the speaking practice stage.

Listening

This section is to help perform listening tasks. It is constructed in stages of 'vocabulary listening - sentence listening - text listening' so the students can reach the level of naturally understanding long texts.




Speaking

This section is to help perform speaking tasks. It is constructed in regards to contents and situation that the students will likely encounter in real life. Aside from dialogues, the students will also practice giving narrative talks including a presentation.



Reading

This section is to help perform reading tasks. The selected reading texts are the ones that the students will encounter in real life and will help the students to perform effective reading practices based on the comprehension of the contents and types of the text.



Writing

This section is to help perform writing tasks. The students will be asked to do types of writing that they will likely to encounter in real life, which will help the students to write effectively according to the types and subjects of the text

Self-Check

In this section, a self check chart is provided in order to evaluate whether one's learning has been successfully accomplished or not. One would not only be able to check how much learning has been accomplished and check his/her weaknesses but one could also find the main function of each unit and could identify areas that he/she has to focus on.



Culture

This section introduces Korean culture that is related to the topic of each unit. With the comprehension of Korean culture as a basis, the students will gain a better understanding of Korean language and will be able to use the language more naturally. When it comes to introducing Korean culture, the contents have been constructed in ways of understanding Korean culture during the process of mutual functioning with the students as they comprehend other cultures as well, rather than just conveying Korean culture alone.



Grammar

This section is to help the grammar comprehension of the students by presenting grammar descriptions from each unit along with exemplary sentences. This part, which is being dealt with items related to class session, is organized and placed at the end of each unit making it easy for each student to find when studying alone and could also play a role as a grammar dictionary. As a chance to practice the grammar, the last two among exemplary sentences are left with blanks for the learner to complete using the grammar they have learned.



Listening Transcript

In this section, all the transcripts for listening activity are presented.



Answers

This section provides answers to questions from listening and reading activities.



Glossary

This section lists all the vocabulary presented in the textbook in an alphabetical order with its meanings and the page number where its explanation is given.


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
